2021 Rules of Play

- ❖ Members must wear their shoe tags at all times.
- ❖ Non-marking tennis shoes are required.
- ❖ Players demonstrating abusive language or other signs of unsuitable bad temper may be asked to leave.
- ❖ Members must keep the combination lock to the entrance gate confidential.
- ❖ Players shall not play on wet courts or when there is thunder and or lightning.
- ❖ Players **MUST** book courts on-line at the club website (to comply with the City's contact tracing requirements) **before coming to the club. No lingering and waiting for pick-up games.**
- ❖ **SINGLES or DOUBLES may be played. If there are less than 4 people playing, please put "None" in the player and contact information fields.**
- ❖ **FOR NON-PRIME TIME ONLY: Continuous 2-hour booking is allowed. ONLY TWO (2) HOURS A DAY IS ALLOWED FOR ALL PLAYERS (Whether you are the person booking or the person(s) playing with the person that booked.**
- ❖ Players can check on-line booking when already at the courts to see if there is available time after original court time to extend court playing time by another 1 hour.
- ❖ **Players who want to book courts for practice purposes (during non-prime time hours only) may do so by putting "practice" under the other mandatory fields. Please put the same telephone number under the other contact number fields.**
- ❖ **Prime-time court bookings must be cancelled by 12pm and at least 1 hour before the booked court time for non-prime-time bookings, if players cannot show up for play.**
- ❖ **Booking courts for the purpose of "HOLDING" will not be tolerated. COURT BOOKINGS are reviewed on a regular basis.**
- ❖ **NO GUESTS allowed due to COVID-19 restrictions.**
- ❖ **PRIME TIME (6:00 p.m. – 11:00 p.m. weekdays and weekends) RULES:**
 - **ONLY ONE (1) HOUR A DAY IS ALLOWED FOR ALL PLAYERS (Whether you are the person booking or the person(s) playing with the person that booked). This is to give those members who work during the day a chance to book courts and play.**
 - **Players can check on-line booking when already at the courts to see if there is available time after original court time to extend court playing time by another 1 hour.**
 - **Juniors may be allowed to play during prime time as long as they are able to rally for 10 consecutive shots at an intermediate pace. Otherwise, please adhere to the Club Member hours.**
 - **No practice during prime time (i.e. no ball hoppers, no practicing against the practice wall)**
- ❖ **All members must read community guidelines and abide by them.**
- ❖ **Warning: These rules must be strictly adhered to, and random checks will be done to ensure rules are complied with. If any of these rules along with the community guidelines are not complied with a warning will be sent to offending members and if further action is needed, membership may and can be revoked.**
 - **1st violation – a warning e-mail will be sent to the member(s)**
 - **2nd violation – member(s) will lose court booking privilege for 1 week**
 - **3rd violation - member(s) will lose court booking privilege for 2 weeks**
 - **4th violation – membership will be revoked with NO REFUND**
- ❖ **We apologize if this seems heavy-handed, but the City Health Authorities will be strictly enforcing the rules. Members who violate these rules may be heavily fined. This could potentially cause the club to lose its permit to operate.**
